The Mudéjar photovoltaic plant will be built on the site of a former coal park for the Andorra thermal power plant, utilizing additional land from the closed "Mas de Perlé" landfill.

The proposed project will combine wind, solar, battery energy storage and green hydrogen to help local industry decarbonise. It includes an option to expand the connection to 1,200MW. [pdf]
