What are application fees?

Application fees are charges that colleges and universities require from prospective students as part of the admissions process. These fees cover the administrative costs associated with processing an application, which typically includes reviewing transcripts, test scores, recommendation letters, and essays.

How much does a college application cost?

Before pressing submit on your college applications, you could be prompted to pay an application fee. Application fees vary depending on the university, program, and school type. But generally, you can expect to pay roughly \$50 per application. We analyzed 2022-2023 application fee information collected by Peterson's Data from over 1,100 colleges.

Do I have to pay an application fee if I apply online?

You may notice that some colleges will say that if you apply online, you do not have to pay an application fee. Other colleges may email you about fee waivers throughout the application process.
