Lockers should be placed in an area that allows full door swing and wheelchair turning ability. Lockers shall be placed in a location at least 24" away from any wall or other obstacle and have a minimum clear floor space of 30" x 48" with a 10" minimum for door swing.

How far from the finished floor should a locker be?

Lockers: At least 5% of the lockers, but not less than one, shall be accessible and shall have locking/opening devices that are operable with a closed fist and mounted no higher than 42 inches ...
