Ohio Edison Company was formed in the early months of the Great Depression and incorporated in June 1930 by The Commonwealth and Southern Corporation to consolidate five Ohio public utility companies.

Ohio Edison (formerly NYSE: OEC) merged with Centerior in 1997 to form FirstEnergy and is one of three FirstEnergy utilities in Ohio (others are The Illuminating Company and Toledo Edison). Ohio Edison offers a number of convenient features:

Is Ohio Edison a publicly traded company?

Ohio Edison Company (formerly OEC on the NYSE) was a publicly traded holding company that began in 1930 with the consolidation of 200 electric companies. By 1950, it ended up with two utility operating companies, Pennsylvania Power and Ohio Edison. It continued in existence until 1997 when its merger with Centerior formed FirstEnergy.
