Who was Clyde Tombaugh?

Clyde Tombaugh, known for his discovery of Pluto in 1930, was born on 4 February 1906 in Streator, Illinois, and died of congestive heart failure on 17 January 1997 in his home in Las Cruces, New Mexico. Clyde spent his childhood on farms in Illinois and Kansas. He was introduced to astronomy by his uncle, who owned a 3-inch telescope.

Clyde Tombaugh was an American astronomer who discovered Pluto in 1930 after a systematic search for a ninth planet instigated by the predictions of other astronomers. He also discovered several clusters of stars and galaxies, studied the apparent distribution of extragalactic nebulae, and made

When did Clyde Tombaugh retire?

The same year the Clyde W. Tombaugh IMAX Theater and Planetarium opened in Alamogordo, New Mexico. In 1986, the Clyde Tombaugh Scholars Fund in support of postdoctoral fellowship at New Mexico State University was established. Dr. Tombaugh conducted astronomical research long after his 1973 retirement.

When did Clyde Tombaugh find Pluto?

Amateur American astronomer Clyde Tombaugh found Pluto in the constellation Gemini on February 18, 1930. How far is Pluto from Sun? Pluto's mean distance from the Sun is about 5.9 billion km (3.7 billion miles or 39.5 astronomical units). Is Pluto's orbit circular or eccentric?
