It is the country's largest electricity producer and operates 18 power stations in Iceland, concentrated on five main areas of operation. The largest local distribution companies are RARIK, ...

We operate fourteen hydropower stations in four operational areas across Iceland. We operate three geothermal power stations, all located in the Northeast. We operate two wind turbines for research ...

The Icelandic Transmission System Operator (TSO) is Landsnet, a company jointly owned by three state-owned power companies: RARIK, Landsvirkjun and Orkubú Vestfjarða.
